

Franklin Park



Franklin Park is 527 acres, with 224 acres of woodlands. Visionary park designer, Frederick Law Olmsted considered it one of his best landscape works. The Loop Path ringing the golf course is about 2.5 miles. A premier cross country course runs through some of the woods today and cross country running at the park dates back to 1912.

It is home to the second oldest public golf course in the country. Cultural festivals draw thousands during the summer.
