- 10. Peters Hill: The highest point in the Emerald Necklace, Peters Hill (240 feet) offers spectacular views of Jamaica Plain, Roslindale, and the Boston skyline.
- 11. Explorers Garden: The area around the Chinese Path has long been used by researchers to test the hardiness of new plants gathered from around the world by plant explorers. Don't miss rare and unusual plants like the dove tree, paperbark maple, or Franklinia.
- 12. Larz Anderson Bonsai Collection: See the oldest and smallest trees at the Arboretum. Open mid-April to early November.
- 13. Hunnewell Building: This building houses administrative offices, a horticultural library, restrooms, and a visitor center with maps, seasonal exhibitions, and knowledgeable staff to help make the most of your visit. Weekday building access for restrooms begins at 9:00am; closed holidays.
