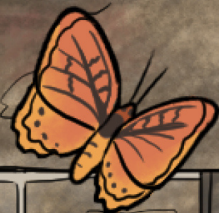
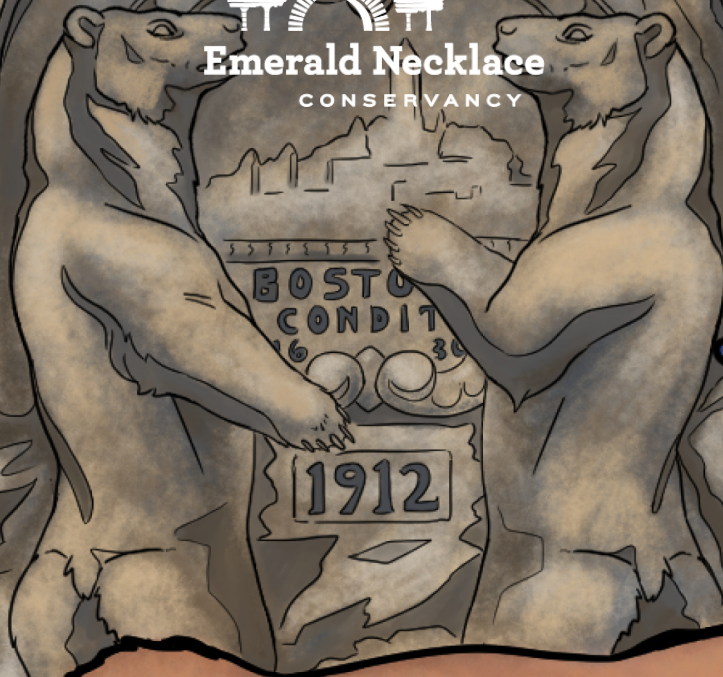

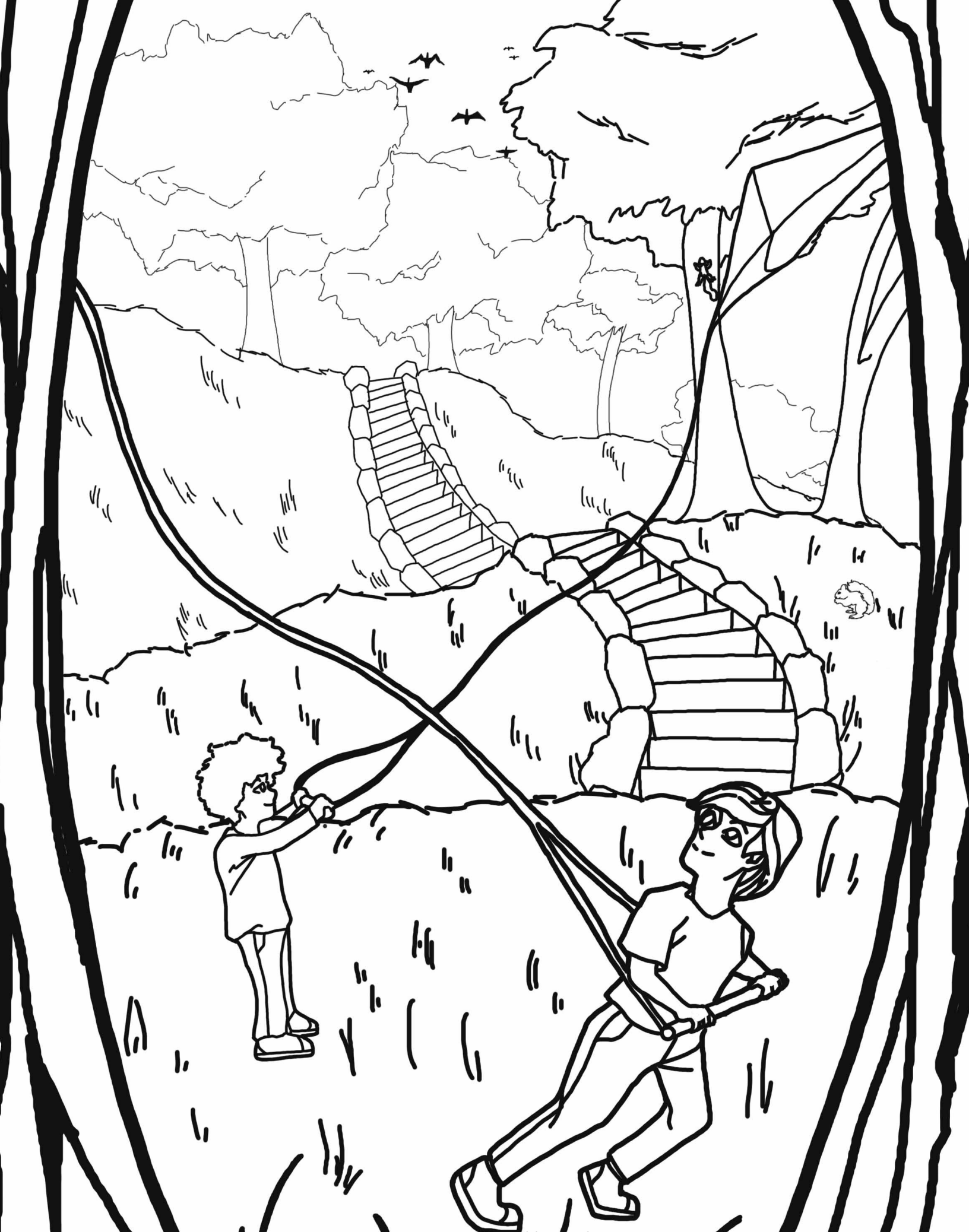
Restoring and improving the Emerald Necklace for all.

The Emerald Necklace Conservancy connects people and parks and conserves the Emerald Necklace – 1,100 acres of parkland that extend from Boston's Back Bay through Brookline and Jamaica Plain to Franklin Park in Dorchester.

We do this through projects that restore and renew the landscape, waterways and parkways, and programs that enrich the visitor experience. The Conservancy collaborates with its public partners on advocacy, maintenance, restoration, education, access improvements and promoting park stewardship via volunteer and youth programs.

In fall 2020, we collaborated with a Professional Illustration class at the neighboring Massachusetts College of Art and Design to create this coloring book, featuring 16 artistic depictions of sites in the Emerald Necklace. 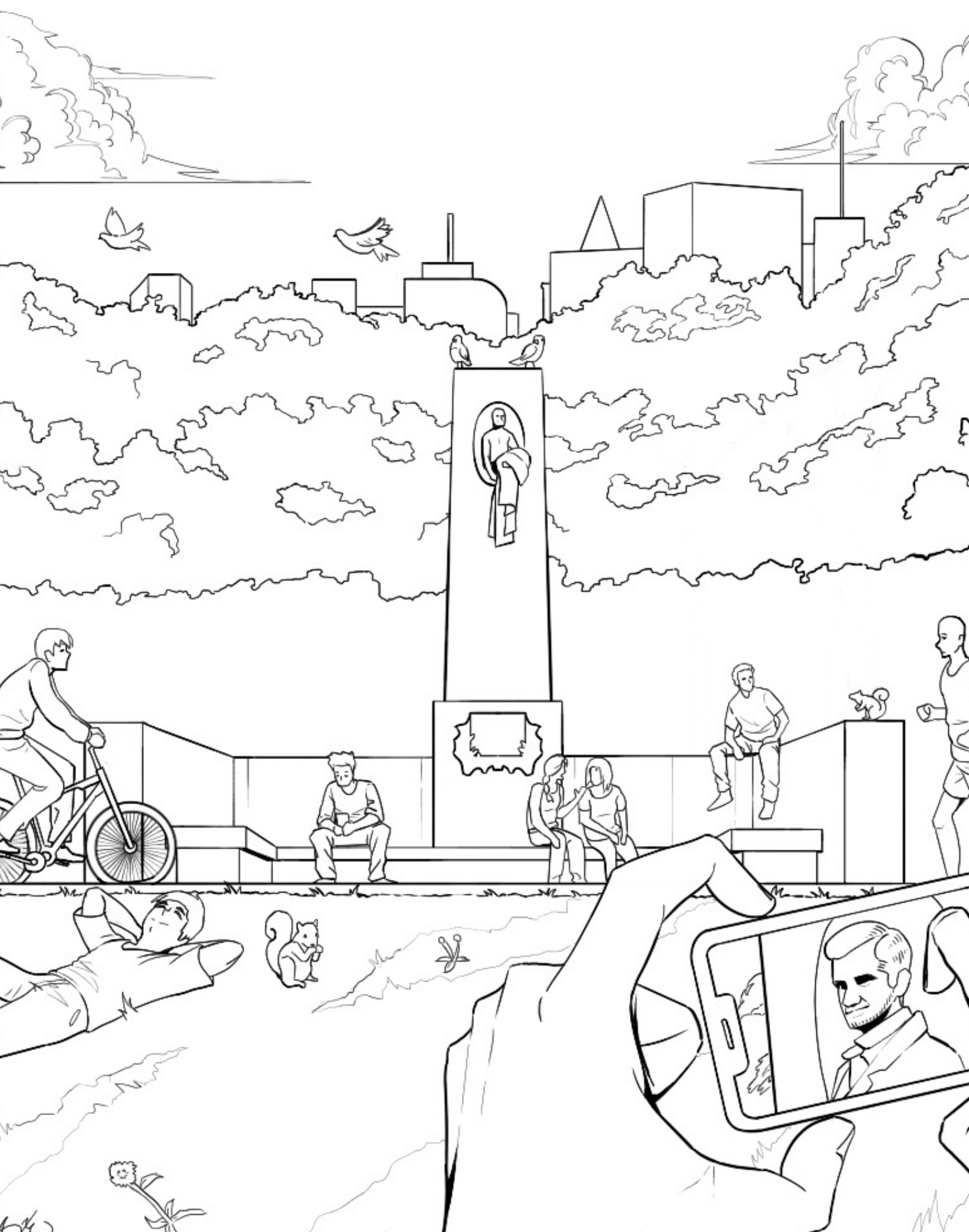

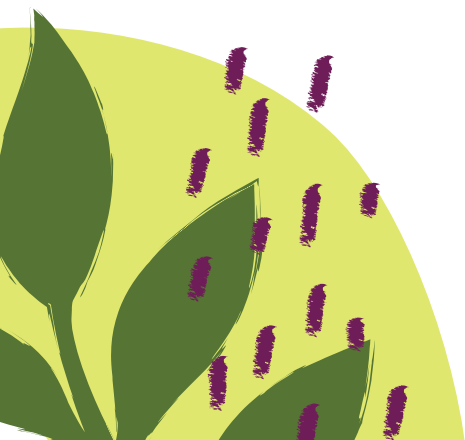
